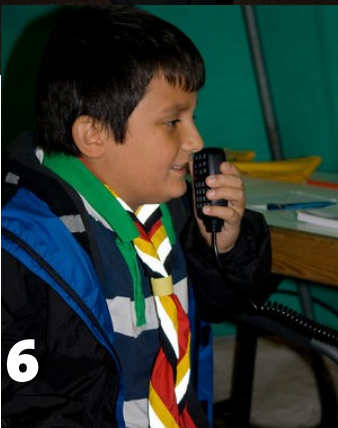


# 1. AIMS & OBJECTIVES
